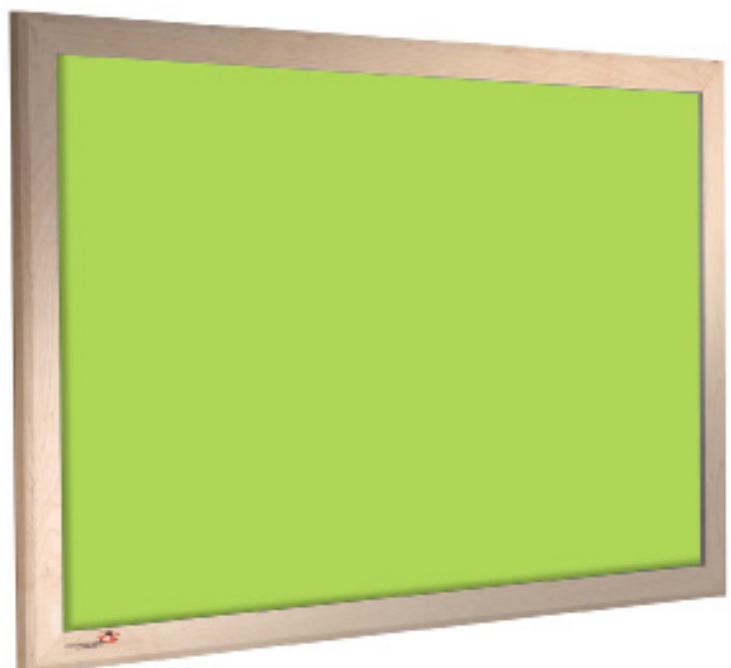
Camira Lucia Fabric noticeboards are manufactured in the UK. Camira Lucia is a high quality fabric manufactured from 100% recycled polyester, designed to complement the Xtreme range of upholstery. We offer it in a range of products - noticeboards, tamperproof lockable boards, mobiles and combination boards.

- Camira Lucia is a recycled polyester crepe weave fabric manufactured from 100% recycled polyester saving virgin raw materials and giving a reduced environmental footprint.
- 9mm pinboard core
- Available in 31 colours
- Choice of Aluminium frame, Hardwood frame (Ash, Beech, Oak and Sapele) and Unframed
- 2 fire ratings - Class 1 and Class B. All public buildings require Class 1 in offices and Class B in corridors and stairwells.
- The fabric is flame retardant to BS476, Part 7 Class 1, EN1021-1 (Cigarette), EN1021-2 (Match), BS7176 Low Hazard, EN13501-1 Adhered Class B, s1, d0 and EN13501-1 Un-adhered Class B, s1, d2.
Note: Flammability performance is dependent on components used.
- Class B Noticeboard only: 9mm Class B Fire Rated backing pinboard; Pinboard core, when tested as a composite panel to the methods of BSEN 12823 and BSEN 11925-2 meet the necessary requirements of EN12501-1:2007 +A1:2009
- This fabric is also largely acoustically transparent and is ideal for use as a decorative facing for sound-absorbing boards

Care and Maintenance

Recommended Procedures

Vacuum or dust down with a soft, clean brush.

Do not use excessive force when removing staples as this may damage the material. To reduce the risk of fire, please make sure that notices on the board do not protrude out of the board and are in single layers. Notice boards should not be fitted near, or directly above any gas heaters or other sources of combustion.
